To carry on the business as manufacturers of and dealers in cosmetics, pharmaceuticals, paints, and other products in the form of aerosol, to

undertake production of raw materials, and components such as propellants, valves, containers, bottles, etc. required for manufacture of aerosol, to undertake such ancillary activities or to procure from the market service for plastics coating of bottles, printing of bottlers, etc. required for manufacture of aerosol. 95. To carry on the business as dealers in hirers, repairers, cleaners, stores, garages of motor cars, motor cycles, aero planes, helicopters, cycles, cars, motors, scooters, bicycles, and carriages, launches, boats and vans and other conveyances of all descriptions (all hereinafter comprised in the term motor and other things) whether propelled or assisted by means of petrol, spirit, steam, gas, electrical, animal or other power and of engines, chassis, bodies and other things, and spare parts, used for in or in connection with motors, and other things, or in the construction of any truck or surface adopted for their use. 96. To carry on the business as carriers, ship owners, charterers of ships or other vessels, warehousemen, ship and insurance brokers, forwarding and clearing agents or in any other capacity in India or elsewhere. 97. To purchase, take on lease or otherwise acquire hold and work on any lands producing rubber

hold and work on any lands producing rubber trees, or suitable for the planting, cultivation and growth of rubber trees, and privileges over any such lands.

98. To carry on the business as manufacturers of dealers in anatomical, orthopedic and surgical appliances of all kinds.

99. To carry on the business of bookmakers, stay makers, corset makers, artificial eye and limb makers, bandages, makers, crutch, chair and stretcher makers, carriage makers, ambulance makers, chemists and druggists? providers of all requisites for hospitals, patents and invalids. 100. To construct cinematograph theatres and other buildings ad works convenient for the purpose thereof, and to manage, maintain and carry on the said theatre and other buildings when so erected or constructed.

101. To search for, get, win, raise, work merchantable, buy and sell or otherwise deal in metals, minerals, oils, grease and fuels, whether found in natural state or obtained by processing form other substances.

102. To carry on in and on the respective branches of all or any of the business of quarry proprietors, stone and grants merchants, dealers and exporters and contractors and to search for, get, win, raise, make marketable use and dispose of granite, stone, coal, minerals and mineral substances and products within or under any property of the company, and to prepare and manufacture cement of any type, paving blocks, tar, muccadams, bituminous road materials. 103. To carry on the business relating to the winning of minerals and production, manufacture,

and preparation of any other materials which may be usefully or conveniently combined with the engineering or manufacturing business of the Company, and either for the purpose only of such contracts or as an independent business. 104. To aid, assist, initiate, promote, expedient, and accelerate the development of agricultural and agricultural operations required for the marketing of agricultural products and to promote, aid, assist or undertake the development of the agricultural market, slaughterhouses and other facilities required for the marketing of agricultural products. 105. To set up and carry on the business of manufacturing, refining, relating, acquiring, buying, selling, importing, exporting, distributing and dealing in any and all kinds of cases of fertilizers including ammonia, urea, organic and inorganic chemicals, seeds, melamine, coal and coke, dyes and intermediate materials for the same, derivatives

and compounds thereof, formulating other chemicals, or industrial preparations arising from or required in the manufacture thereof. 106. To provide irrigation services to farmers and co-operative farmers and for improving irrigation, to sink sells, shafts, construct dams, bunds, culverts, cisterns, reservoirs and filter beds, and to provide main and other acts and things necessary for obtaining, storing, supplying, measuring and dwelling in water for the purpose of providing irrigation facilities to agricultural sector. 107. To develop, aid, assist, initiate, promote organize and finance units and agencies in the fields of marketing, processing warehousing and cold storage of agriculture produce and byproducts

thereof.

108. To carry on the business of manufacturers of and dealers in tobacco, cigar, cigarettes, match lights, pipes and other articles required by or which may be convenient to smokers and of snuff grinders, and merchants, and to deal in any other articles and things, commonly dealt with tobacconists.

109. To own, prepare, develop or otherwise make fit or use, any land or properties, which can be put to use for breeding of horses or for being converted into stud farm and also to own, breed or otherwise maintain horses, pigs, or other animals for being put to use commercially.

110. To finance the industrial enterprises by way of lending and advancing money, machinery, land, building, sheet or such other things as may be required by such industrial enterprises either with or without security and such terms and conditions as Company deem fit and to guarantee any contract entered into by industrial enterprise with any financial institution, banks or other parties for obtaining finance whether for long term, capital, working capital for deferred payment financial and negotiable loans in any

form and manner and also to give any guarantee for payment of moneys or performance of any obligation or undertaking and to assist/finance trading and manufacturing activities, business transaction and to act as financial consultant and advisors. 111. To carry on business as builder, construction contractor, surveyors, quarry master, architects, exterior and interior decorators and to provide amusement park thereof and developers. 112. To buy, sell, take on lease or enlarge, pull down, remove, replace or in exchange, acquire any estate, land, building, easement or any other rights

and interest in immovable property, roads, bridges, reservoirs, water courses, wharves, electrical works and any other works which may be calculated directly or indirectly to advance the interest of the company.

4 The liability of the member(s) is limited, and this liability is limited to the amount unpaid if any, on the shares held by them.

5 Every member of the company undertakes to contribute:

(i) to the assets of the company in the event of its being wound up while he is a member, or within one year after he ceases to be a member, for payment of the debts and liabilities of the company or of such debts and liabilities as may have been contracted before he ceases to be a member; and

(ii) to the costs, charges and expenses of winding up (and for the adjustment of the rights of the contributories among themselves), such amount as may be required, not exceeding * rupees.
